Culturing Specimens

Unacceptable Specimens (Will Be Rejected)

- 1. Unlabeled specimen; specimen with only one identifier; non-matching identifiers
- 2. Leaking or damaged containers
- 3. Specimens in syringes with attached needles (even if capped)
- 4. Specimens with prolonged transport times
- 5. Duplicate specimens (except blood and tissue): same site, same day, same test

Urine	Unpreserved > 2 hrs, cold > 24 hrs, preserved
	> 72 hrs, pooled specimens, foley catheter tips
Tissue	In non-sterile container, dry
Sputum	Pooled Specimens
Anaerobic Culture	Specimen other than: Tissue in a cup, fluid in a
	syringe, swab in an anaerobic transport device
	Never acceptable: Aerobic swab, sputum,
	bronchial, tracheal, throat, mouth/oral, nasal,
	N/P, urine, gastric, stones, superficial skin, GI
	fistula, GI tract
AFB Culture	Specimen on a swab
C. Difficile	Formed stool, duplicate orders
