### TOPIC: New Orderable Test Code in Cerner for CD4:CD8 Testing

In order to provide a result field to track CD4:CD8 HIV results a new test code has been established in Cerner (T-Help Panel).

The current workflow of ordering a Pathology Blood Flow and commenting CD4:CD8 testing will be replaced with T-Helper (CD4) Subset Panel-Blood. The results will then be available in individual result fields under Miscellaneous Hematology as opposed to looking within a pathology report.
