Beginning on **9/15/2026**, the **Semen Analysis Fertility Testing Panel** will be available for ordering. This test determines the fertility potential of a male.

Collection Requirements: Collection instructions are attached and may be found at camc.testcatalog.org (search “fertility) or [this link](#). Samples must be received in the laboratory **within 30 minutes of collection** and **kept at body temperature** during transportation.

COLLECTION INSTRUCTIONS FOR SEMEN ANALYSIS:

- 2-7 days abstinence from ejaculation prior to specimen collection.
- Collect sample by **masturbation only**.
- Lubricants, spermicides and other contaminants are not to be used.
- The entire specimen must be collected into a clean container (supplied by the physician's office or the laboratory).
- The specimen container should be clearly labeled with the patient's name, date of birth and other identifying information.
- Transport the specimen to the laboratory right after collection. Specimen must be received in automated procedures laboratory within 30 minutes of collection.
- Keep the sample at body temperature during transportation. Do not heat or cool the sample or the container.
